### **Senior Waste Management Coordinator**

The Ministry of Environment's Municipal Branch in Regina requires a Senior Waste Management Coordinator. This position involves working on a number of key initiatives including the implementation of a provincial Multi-Material Recycling Program, a provincial strategy for solid waste management, Household Hazardous Waste initiatives and solid waste regulatory reform.

The successful candidate will develop and deliver ministry programs, regulations, codes of practice, policies and protocols with respect to solid waste management and recycling. You will facilitate meetings with clients and stakeholders and investigate complaints and facilitate resolution of issues. This position will identify and aid in conducting environmental studies and will be responsible for work leading to the initiation of pollution prevention and Reduce, Reuse and Recycle programs in Saskatchewan.

Our candidate of choice will bring strong knowledge of sustainable development, waste management and recycling practices and environmental protection management. Knowledge of current environmental trends and issues in waste and recycling management nationally and internationally will be required. In addition, the candidate will need to demonstrate adeptness in project management and the tools used to successfully complete project goals. The successful candidate will have the demonstrated ability to influence, persuade and convince others and develop, engage, and maintain effective partnerships with diverse stakeholder groups. You will have the capacity to undertake public policy development in the area of recycling and formulate policy options, analyze trends, conduct critical research analysis to develop strategies for legislation and program renewal. Strong oral and written communication skills as well as solid facilitation skills will be crucial to the success of this position as this role will be involved in developing Environmental Codes of Practice and legislation related to solid waste management and recycling programs.

Typically the competencies required for this position will have been attained through a completion of a graduate degree in environmental sciences or public policy combined with experience in municipal solid waste management and recycling programs.
